In 2014, Pharmacists Mutual introduced our members to 3SI's **PharmaTracker[®]**. The covert tracking device detects motion and uses GPS, cell and radio frequency to automatically and silently notify both 3SI and local law enforcement that a burglary or robbery has occurred.

In early 2015, we partnered with 3SI to provide **PharmaTracker[®]** to members at an exclusive 15% discount. The discount reduces the initial cost of installation and one year of monitoring from \$864 – \$425 for the device, \$264 first year usage, \$75 installation fee and \$30 charger. With the discount the first year cost is \$734. Year 2 and beyond will require a \$264 annual monitoring fee. (*Prices effective as of 1/17/2017 and are subject to change.*)

Because of our belief in the value of the device in apprehending criminals, we are now also willing to waive up to \$1,000 of your property deductible for a claim due to burglary or robbery, if the pharmacy has an active tracking device on site at the time of the crime.
